Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we look to starting our new **2022-23 Parish School of Religion (PSR) year**, we ask you to continue to communicate to your child(ren) in word and action how you value your faith and rely on it to meet each day. We are here to assist you and your children as you walk on your own journey of faith as a family.

We want to see more of our children back in the classroom setting. **Homeschooling** may become an option you choose if there are circumstances that make coming to class weekly difficult. Please call me for a conversation.

Students in grade 2 and 8 are expected to be here for classroom instruction based on the year being one in which they prepare to receive their First Eucharist/Reconciliation (gr.2) or the Sacrament of Confirmation (gr.8). Separate mailings will be sent to families with children in either of the two sacrament programs.

The forms enclosed need to be filled out and returned to the Parish Office by **August 27**. They include the forms for registration, health information and volunteering.

PSR Fee for Grades 1-8:
\$65.00 for one child; \$120.00 for two; \$160 for three or more

Checks are to be made out to **Saint Anselm PSR**. Though our hope would be that the fee(s) would accompany the returned forms, it is most important to have the forms handed in so as to help facilitate the number of classrooms needed as well as the number of catechists and aides. **Note: Fee is the same as pre-Covid.** I had failed to change the cost last year.

Please take time in completing all the sections of each form on both sides. There will be a **late fee of \$5** for any registration turned in **after August 27th**.

Carefully read all forms. The picture permission is for the taking and use of the photos within our parish community (bulletins/not online).

Please take time to consider being a part of our program **by volunteering** in some way. This year we will need **catechists in grades 1,4, 5 and 6**. It is also a wonderful witness of your faith by the students and especially your child(ren). I think you will find your own faith will grow.

Aides are also important to the catechists and children by providing the presence of another adult in interacting with children and assisting the catechist.

PSR hours

Grades 1-5 begins on Saturday, Sept.17th from 9:00 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.

Grades 6-8 begins on Sunday, Sept.18th from 7:00 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.

Children's Liturgy of the Word: This gathering takes place during 9:00 Mass for children 4 years old to 9 years old. A catechist meets with the children in sharing the Mass Readings at their level as the Readings are read in the church and as Father presents a homily. We could use people to facilitate this gathering as well. Generally a catechist is committed to one Sunday a month.
